Internships are required for Law and Justice majors, and our faculty go all out in making sure students get a good internship that is relevant to their interests and future careers.

A: Before graduating from Rowan, Law and Justice Studies majors already have firsthand experience in the fields they wish to enter. We offer internships in many areas, such as law offices, law enforcement, security, prosecutors' offices, etc.

A: A degree in Law and Justice Studies is flexible enough that a student could use it to get into almost any job. In particular, though, the degree is best used for getting jobs such as police work, law enforcement, councilors, lawyers, park administration, parole officers, etc.
