Big Interview Mock Interview Tool: Instructions & Resources

Creating an Account:

- 1. Visit the following website (rowan.biginterview.com) and click "Register for Free".
- 2. Review and complete the remainder of the registration questions to create an account.

Completing a Mock Interview:

- 1. Upon logging into the website, click "Interviews" at the top of the screen. Students will then click on "Practice Sets", which is located under the "Practice" option.
- 2. Students can select an interview from various industries, graduate programs, government positions, and general jobs at a wide variety of levels (entry level, mid level, senior level, management positions, etc.). For this tutorial, we will showcase how to complete a general interview, but users can select any interview option they wish to complete. For the general interview, click on "General Start Here: Covers 80% of the interview questions you might get" option.
- 3. View the "Entry Level" offerings, and under "Standard", click on "Practice with Jiyoung".
- 4. Users will be directed to a new webpage that entails a recording of an interview question and a camera that states, "Record your answer for this question". Students will click on the recording to hear the interview question and then click on "Start Recording" when ready to record their answers. Students will have the option to record themselves as many times as they want to perfect their answers.
- 5. After students feel comfortable with their recording, they click "Save Answer" to upload their questions into the system. After their answer has been uploaded, students will click on "Next Question".
- 6. Students will complete steps 4 5 for questions 1 to 10. These questions include the following:
 - a. Thanks for coming in. I have your resume here. Can you just walk me through your background?
 - b. Why are you interested in working for this company?
 - c. Why are you interested in this particular job?
 - d. How has your education prepared you for this role?
 - e. Why did you choose the school that you attended?
 - f. How does your previous experience relate to this job?
 - g. What do you like to do in your spare time?
 - h. What are your greatest strengths?
 - i. What are your long-term career goals?
 - j. Do you have any questions for me?
- 7. At this point, students' interview questions will be saved for their review. Students can then review their answers or complete other practice interviews.
