

**Program Guide for CUGS in NJ Amistad Law and African American Studies for
Future Educators**
12 semester hours (s.h.)

All courses listed are 3 s.h. each. Students must take AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies* to fulfill prerequisite requirements for most of the other required courses. Otherwise, courses may be taken in any sequence.

Required Courses (9 s.h.):

- AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies*
 - This course counts for Rowan Core Humanities Literacy
- HIST 05376 *African American History to 1865* **OR** HIST 05377 *African American History since 1865*
 - Students may fulfill prerequisites by taking COMP II *College Composition II* and AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies*
- 3. ENGL 02380 *African American Literature* **OR** ENGL 02.123 *TPS Lit: African American Lit*
 - Students who take ENGL 02380 *African American Literature* **OR** ENGL 02.123 *TPS Lit: African American Lit* may fulfill prerequisite requirements by taking COMP 01112 *College Composition II* and AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies*.

Elective: (3 s.h.) Any ONE of the following courses:

- HIST 05376 *African American History to 1865* **OR** HIST 05377 *African American History since 1865* (if not taken as one of the requirements)
 - Students may fulfill prerequisites by taking COMP II *College Composition II* and AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies*
- HIST 05373 *Civil Rights/Black Power Movement*
 - Students may fulfill prerequisites by taking COMP II *College Composition II* and AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies*
- HIST 05394 *Sub-Saharan Africa to 1800*
 - Students may fulfill prerequisites by taking COMP II *College Composition II* and AFST 11104 *Introduction to Africana Studies*
 - History majors are encouraged to take this course to fulfill one of their Global history requirements
- SOCI 08488 *Critical Race Theory: Social Justice, Advocacy and Intervention*
 - SOC 0120 *Introduction to Sociology* and SOC 08230 *Sociology Of Minority Groups* are prerequisites
- POSC 07323 *The Politics of Poverty: Class, Gender, and Race in America*
- POSC 07324 *The Politics of Race in American Society*
- AFST 11350 *Topics: Black Lives Matter: An Ethnographic Perspective of the Movement*
- ENGL 02380 *African American Literature* **OR** ENGL 02.123 *TPS Lit: African American Lit* (if not taken as one of the requirements)
