

4+1 BA/MBA Applications Due 2/16 (extended)

This accelerated dual degree program allows students to earn a B.A. in International Studies with a Concentration in International Business & Economics and an M.B.A. in only five years. Students take courses required for the International Studies major as well as courses required as prerequisites for the M.B.A. Assuming they have met requirements, students in this program may take 12 credits of the 36 credit M.B.A. program as a senior, saving time--and 12 credits of graduate tuition and fees.

Applications for fall 2018 entry into the program are due on February 16, 2018. To be eligible for admission into the program, you must have earned at least 60 credits, have an overall GPA of 3.3 or higher, and have completed all MBA prerequisites and International Studies requirements listed on the website:
