Sweeney Center Conference on Offshore Wind Technology will be held Wednesday, May 3, at Rowan University

GLASSBORO – The Steve Sweeney Center for Public Policy is bringing together government leaders, industry officials and academics for a May 3 conference on "Offshore Wind Technology in New Jersey: Sustainability, Emerging Markets and Policy."

Among the top policymakers addressing the conference will be Congressman Donald Norcross (D-N.J.); Robert Asaro-Angelo, Commissioner of the N.J. Department of Labor and Workforce Development; Shawn LaTourette, Commissioner of the state Department of Environmental Protection; and Tim Sullivan, CEO of the N.J. Economic Development Authority.
