English Minor Program Guide (18 credits)

The English minor offers students sustained training in English literature through an abbreviated sequence of major courses. The English minor is for students who recognize the value of studying literature as a way to engage culture and history, language and narrative, and aesthetics and creativity, while also building critical thinking and communication skills.

Students must take the following course:

Students must also take <u>five additional</u> English courses.

- Two of these <u>can be</u> 100-level Rowan Core English courses.
- One of these English courses <u>must be</u> at the 300-level or higher.
