**Concentration in Global Literatures in English
(12 credits)**

This 12-hour Concentration in Global Literatures in English is designed for students interested in English as a global language encompassing diverse perspectives, histories, and literary traditions. It will prepare students for careers in fields that value intercultural fluency and global understanding.

Students are required to complete this course first:

- **Critical Methods for English Majors II (ENGL 02.202)** **3 s.h.**
 - Prerequisite: Critical Methods for English Majors I (ENGL 02.101)

Students will then complete any three of the following courses: **9 s.h.**

- **World Mythologies (ENGL 02.231)**
 - No pre- or corequisites
- **Special Topics in Global Literatures in English (ENGL 02.475) or Special Topics in Literature with a global focus (ENGL 02.417)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112), Critical Methods for English Majors I (ENGL 02.101) *and* Critical Methods for English Majors II (ENGL 02.202)
- **Global Modernisms: [subtitle] (ENGL 02.473)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112), Critical Methods for English Majors I (ENGL 02.101) *and* Critical Methods for English Majors II (ENGL 02.202)
- **Senior Seminar with a global focus (ENGL 02.499)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112), Critical Methods for English Majors I (ENGL 02.101) *and* Critical Methods for English Majors II (ENGL 02.202), and 18 credits within the major

Note: Students who wish to use the Senior Seminar as part of this Concentration must get permission from the faculty member teaching the Senior Seminar section to ensure its global focus.
