**Certificate of Undergraduate Study in Multiethnic American Literatures
(12 credits, program code U187)**

This 12-hour Certificate offers students the opportunity to study, in depth, key texts and contexts of ethnic American literatures. Students will cultivate a critical awareness of the ways in which mutually constitutive categories of ethnicity, race, indigeneity, class, gender, and sexuality inform the evolution of African American, Asian American, Latino/a, and Native American literary canons.

Students are required to complete one of the following courses first:

- **Critical Methods I for English Majors (ENGL 02.101)** **3 s.h.**
 - No pre- or corequisites
- **Multiethnic Literatures of the United States (ENGL 02.218)**
 - No pre- or corequisites

Students will then complete three courses from the list below. Note: to ensure students have the opportunity to engage intensively as many of the four major areas of study that fall under the umbrella of Multiethnic Literatures of the United States—Asian American, Native American, Latino/a, and African American Literatures—students who choose to study African American literature may take only one of the two course offerings in this area (either ENGL 02.354 or ENGL 02.355, but not both) for Certificate credit.

- **Native American Literature (ENGL 02.212)** **9 s.h.**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition I (COMP 01.111) or Intensive College Composition I (COMP 01.105)
- **African American Literature I (ENGL 02.354)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Multiethnic Literatures of the United States (ENGL 02.218) or College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Critical Methods I for English Majors (ENGL 02.101)
- **African American Literature II (ENGL 02.355)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Multiethnic Literatures of the United States (ENGL 02.218) or College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Critical Methods I for English Majors (ENGL 02.101)
- **Asian American Literature (ENGL 02.360)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Multiethnic Literatures of the United States (ENGL 02.218) or College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Critical Methods I for English Majors (ENGL 02.101)
- **U.S. Latino/a Literature (ENGL 02.365)**
 - Prerequisites: College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Multiethnic Literatures of the United States (ENGL 02.218) or College Composition II (COMP 01.112) and Critical Methods I for English Majors (ENGL 02.101)
