SPANISH MINOR

The Spanish Minor, which may be declared in the World Languages Department in Bunce Hall, Suite 305, with Christine Larsen-Britt (larsen-britt@rowan.edu) in Suite 218, Bunce Hall, at the University Advising Center, Suite 323, Savitz Hall, or at the Registrar's Office, Suite 121, Savitz Hall, offers a flexible curriculum with many opportunities for selection of courses in the Spanish language and in Spanish and Spanish American civilization, culture, literature and linguistics. It provides a general background for future professional studies and advanced degrees in Spanish and work in a wide variety of fields, such as social, administrative and governmental work, as well as international business.

Students with existing proficiency in Spanish should contact Esther Mas (mas@rowan.edu) regarding the placement exam. Students may earn the credits for any skipped courses via the Authorization for Credit by Examination process and these credits are counted in fulfillment of minor requirements.

In order to satisfy the requirements for the Spanish Minor, students must take 18 SH credits in Spanish. These 18 SH may be completed through:

- Taking any of the courses listed below, each of which is 3 credits. All courses must be passed with a letter grade of "C-" or better and no courses may be taken P/NC.
- Transferring credits into the Spanish Minor, including from study abroad, and up to 9 s.h. from Advanced Placement and the CLEP Exam. Students planning to study abroad must meet with the Program Advisor in order to determine course equivalents.

Any 6 of the following 3 SH courses may be used toward the Spanish Minor:

Spanish I (SPAN 05.101)	(no prerequisite)
Spanish II (SPAN 05.102)	(prereq. Spanish I or waiver)
Spanish III (SPAN 05.201)	(prereq. Spanish II or waiver)
Spanish Reading and Conversation (SPAN 05.211)	(prereq. Spanish III or waiver)
Spanish Reading and Composition (SPAN 05.212)	(prereq. Spanish Rdg. & Conv. or waiver)
Spanish Phonetics (SPAN 05.300)	(prereq. Spanish Rdg. & Conv. or waiver)
Oral Spanish (SPAN 05.305)	(prereq. Spanish Rdg. & Conv. or waiver)
<u>Any other 300/400 level courses in Spanish</u>
