*Spanish is the only Advanced Language option that can be completed entirely on Rowan's campus; students who select a language other than Spanish as the Advanced Language must meet with Dr. Manley (manley@rowan.edu), Chair, to discuss Rowan study abroad options and for approval to transfer in 300/400-level courses taken at other institutions in order to complete the program.

While any languages may be declared as the Advanced Language and the Intermediate Language, including those completed through study abroad, students may choose to declare the existing MLL Concentrations (consisting of four courses) in American Sign Language (C100), French (C102), German (C103), Italian (C104), Spanish (C105), Japanese (C106), Chinese (C107), Arabic (C108), and Russian (C109). Students may skip levels through a placement exam/interview and earn credits for skipped courses.
