Rowan University has "3+3" agreements with three law schools- Delaware Law School (of Widener University), Drexel University- Thomas R. Kline Law School, and Rutgers Law School- in which a student who completes major and core requirements, approximately 75% of his or her overall undergraduate credits, and who meets law school admissions requirements can have their first year of law school simultaneously count as their final undergraduate year and earn a bachelor's degree and law degree in six years instead of seven. Law School Scholarship opportunities are also part of these agreements.
